## First Remote Patient Records and 12 Clinic Questions During the **Epidemic of COVID-19**

Abstract: Covid-19 is a statutory infectious disease, which has become pandemic in many countries around the world. Many countries have to lockdown the city, lockdown the country and isolate between people. During the Covid-19 period, due to the special situation of CM in the United Kingdom, the CM clinics could only be 'closed' and turned online to help the patients who seek CM treatment services in the United Kingdom. CM clinic online service is a new thing. In order to have a more detailed record of patient information, avoid unnecessary economic and legal disputes, and enable later research conclusions, we have designed ""First Remote Patient Records During the Epidemic of COVID-19" and "Remote 12 Clinic Questions During the Epidemic of COVID-19" and "Remote Clinic 12 Questions During the Epidemic of COVID-19" We hope this will help CM practitioners who can provide remote online services during Covid-19 period.

Epidemic and infectious Covid-29 has become prevalent in many countries around the world since December 2019. The World Health Organization (WHO 2020) announced that the disease caused by the infection of the new coronavirus (2019-nCoV) will be officially named "COVID-19". On the same day, the International Committee for Classification of Viruses declared that the new coronavirus that caused the disease was named "SARS-CoV-2" [1]. The Covid-19 is highly contagious and has a high mortality rate (Johns Hopkins University, USA, 2020), as of April 4, 2020, the number of confirmed cases of global new Covid-19 has reached 1,094,068 cases, and the cumulative death cases are 51,485. A total of 225,519 cases were cured. A total of 38,168 cases were diagnosed in the UK, and a total of 3,605 deaths [2]. Chinese medicine plays an important role in preventing and treating Covid-19's anti-epidemic. In Chinese National

Guidelines for the Prevention and Treatment of Covid-19 Diseases clarify the clinical treatment and prescriptions of the fourth stage by using CM (China National Health and Health Commission, 2020) [3].

In the UK so far, because of the special situation of CM in the UK, no CM has been involved in the treatment of the Covid-19 in National Health Service at hospitals. And according to the Covid-19 regulation of the UK the CM clinics in the UK should be closed. However, the CM practitioners in the UK actively participated in the remote consultation of the 'Volunteer Expert Groups ' during the epidemic of the Covid-19 period in the UK, including telephone, email, WebChat, etc., to serve patients in the UK seeking CM help.

Remote consultation is a new form of CM treatment. This is in order to relieve the pressure on CM practitioners and CM applicants, to query and record more systematically within a limited time, to avoid unnecessary disputes, and to enable scientific statistics, analysis and summary. According to the characteristics of the Covid-19 period, the Research Committee of the Associated Traditional Chinese Medicine and Acupuncture UK has designed the "First Remote Patient Records During the Epidemic of COVID-19" and "Remote 12 Clinic Questions During the Epidemic of COVID-19 "as follows:
